Current programs in place include:

BINGO @ Carleton Place Bingo Hall Every Friday night at 7:00 and 10:00 p.m. **MAJOR FUNDRAISER** Provides 80% of budget!	Bingo workers are needed for ONE session every 4th week . It would require three hours of your time, arriving 30 minutes before each bingo starts (6:30 & 9:30 p.m.) <small>smoking environment</small>
Tag Days (2)	Tag days require volunteers to drive cadets to pre-determined areas, introduce themselves & cadets to the contact at their location, return cans to the corps and help count the funds.
Christmas Holiday Basket(s)	Help cadets sell tickets. This may include selling outside of a store or designated area at a specified time.
Baked Goods and/or Pot Lucks	When required for special events or cadet activities (i.e. visiting corps / camp info night).
Building Operations & Maintenance	Help is needed in the areas of painting, carpentry, electrical and general upkeep.
